Your task is to copy the sentences down and get the spelling of the homophones correct (as well as the other words in the sentences!).	English Using your knowledge of Henry VIII and his 6 marriages write a balance argument about whether Henry VIII was right to marry 6 times. Remember that a balanced argument needs to have: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Title • Opening statement to introduce the argument • Arguments for and against • Evidence to support arguments • Written in third person • Concluding paragraph to say what you think (first person) • Technical words • Complex and compound sentences • Causal conjunctions – because, so, therefore, consequently
