English

- We will be using RWInc Talk Through Stories high quality texts to develop our vocabulary and comprehension.
- We will use RWInc Phonics daily to practice reading and writing.
- Year 2 children will use the text The Great Fire of London: An Illustrated History of the Great Fire of 1666 by Emma Adams and James Weston Lewis to inspire their writing.

Maths

This term we will be exploring:

- Subtraction including problem solving.
- Money
- Multiplication
- Number & Place Value
- Properties of 2D shapes

PE

This term's indoor PE session is athletics and we will have Forest School outdoors.

Science

This term we are continuing our learning on materials.

- We will investigate which ball is the bounciest.
- We will find out which materials are flexible, rigid, stretchy, squashy, elastic, or stiff.
- We will also investigate which material would be best to make a catapult.

Computing

We will be programming a moving robot.

- We will explore using individual commands.
- We will identify what each command for the floor robot does.
- We will use that knowledge to start making the robot move on a route we will create.
