English – Create an information leaflet about the village you live in. Science – Choose 5 animals that live in the desert. Find out which group the animals would be sorted into and draw a classification key to show characteristics.	Computing – The children have been introduced to Scratch – an online coding programme. Please start your animation by choosing a backdrop and two sprites. You need to write a programme that involves both of your sprites moving and making a noise.	
RE – Think about or research images from the natural world that inspire you and draw a picture of them or write a poem about them.
