We will be reading and giving grid references and using these to navigate routes.

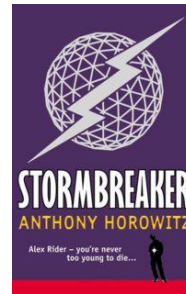
We will be making our own maps.
