As Coningsby Authors we will...

be responding to our text for this term "Carrie's War" We will learn how to write horror stories based on a theme within the text and we will also write some poetry related to The Blitz.

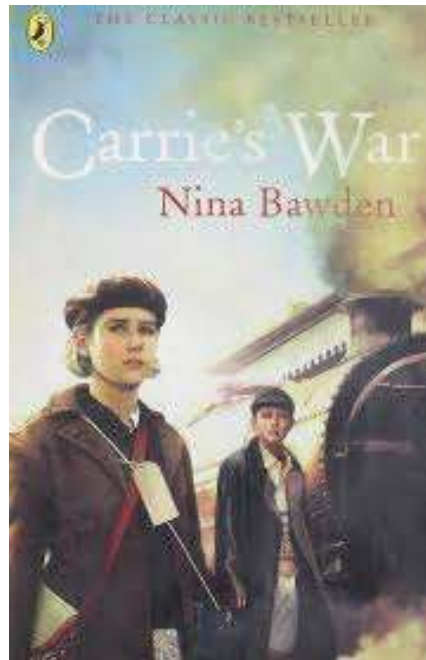
As Coningsby Historians we will...

be learning about the countries involved, key events and who the leaders were in World War II – Neville Chamberlain, Winston Churchill, Adolf Hitler, Benito Mussolini. We will also discuss societal roles and how this has influenced the world today. We will make links to our local area, particularly the role of the air bases during this war.

As Coningsby Scientists we will...

be exploring life cycles of plants (flowering and non-flowering), mammals and birds. We will compare the stages of life cycles and identify features of these plants/ animal groups.

As part of our science work this term we will be growing a range of plants which are to be planted in the school grounds.



As Coningsby Mathematicians we will...

focus on adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions. We will be calculating fractions of varying amounts and identifying decimal and percentage equivalents of different fractions.

As Coningsby believers we will...

read and discuss the Bible story – 'The Last Supper – Mark 14:22–26 and discuss our core value of Thankfulness.

In RE, we will be continuing to focus on Christianity exploring whether Jesus was the Saviour of mankind.
