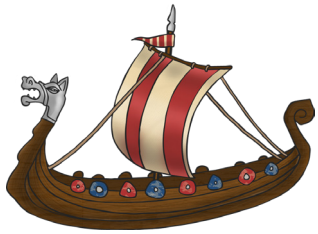


AD 1013

AD 866



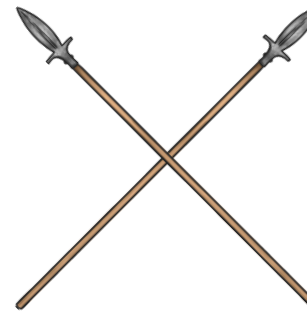
The Vikings capture the city of York.
