## 5 Term 1 Curriculum

As Coningsby Scientists we will...

As Coningsby Artists & Designers we will...

be using printing techniques to create Anglo-Saxon themed fabrics.



As Coningsby Mathematicians we will...

focus on place value, methods of addition, subtraction and statistics. We will continue to develop our mental arithmetic skills by improving our recall of key number facts. We will apply our learning through mastery (problem-solving) activities each week. We are also introducing Times Table Rockstars which the children can access at home for further practice.

As Coningsby believers we will...

read and discuss the Bible story – ‘Jesus and the children. Zacchaeus: The story of how a man was changed by the friendship of Jesus - Luke 19 V1-10’ and discuss our core value or Friendship.

In RE, we will be looking at Hinduism. We will be drawing similarities and differences between Hindu and Christian beliefs and researching how worship takes place in each religion.
