POINTILLISM

This is a method of painting made famous by a French artist called Georges Seurat. His most famous painting is called

« Un dimanche après-midi à l'Île de La Grande Jatte » which means "A Sunday afternoon on the island of La Grande Jatte". La Grande Jatte is an island in the middle of the River Seine, near Paris.

He also painted a picture of the Eiffel Tower.

If you look carefully at these paintings, you will see that they are made up of a series of dots.

I would like you to choose a famous French landmark.

(I have included some outlines but you don't have to use these; they are just useful if you are stuck for an idea).

Write a paragraph about the landmark you have chosen.

Draw an outline of your landmark on a large piece of paper. Then use an ear bud (Q tip) to DOT the paint on to the outline. This will create your very own Pointillist painting.
