<p>The activities listed below are a guideline of work that you could support your child to complete during this week of school closure.</p> <p>Please continue to read regularly at home, daily if possible but at least 4 times a week. This can be found on your year group page in the website.</p> <p>Please open the word of the day document on the website and choose a word. English – Write a letter as if you are an evacuee back to your parents and family.  Research the planes that were used during WWII and create a fact file about your favourite.  Read and then write a book review detailing the parts you enjoyed and suggest any improvements, if any?	English – Everyday choose 5 spellings from either the year 3/4 or 5/6 spelling list, which is in the back of your planner or can be found online, and practise these in different ways.	Science – Create a life cycle of an animal of your choice. Include images and text to explain this process.	Music – Listen and watch the video “Two Steps From Hell – Victory (WWII Cinematic)” <i>WWII style instrumental battle soundtrack</i> . Write or draw what the composer is trying to convey to the listener and how this is being done.	
RE – As we have been learning about the reason Jesus came to Earth as the saviour of mankind, we would like you to research how Christmas is celebrated in different countries around the world. A useful website to help you to do this would be <a href="http://www.whychristmas.com/cultures">www.whychristmas.com/cultures</a>	Maths – Continue practising your work about adding and subtracting fractions – remembering denominators will need to be the same in order to add/subtract the numerators.  There are many resources available to do this and please be aware that <a href="http://www.twinkl.co.uk">www.twinkl.co.uk</a> is allowing free access for a month.	History – Investigate how Lincolnshire became known as Bomber County. Record your findings in whichever way you feel is most appropriate. You may find this easier if you select a local airbase such as RAF Coningsby, RAF Scampton or RAF Waddington.	PE – Find Joe Wicks on Youtube. Find one of his Five Minute Move kids workout videos.	
Reading – Children should be encouraged to read every day. Please encourage your child to read a variety of books for at least 20 – 30 minutes everyday and discuss with them what they have read.		Maths – Please complete at least 5 games on garage and 5 games on studio everyday. Please use the opportunity in the multiplayer games to play against friends or other children around the country.
