Welcome back to our new term.

Please remember this term... Reading books and reading records in school every day. Homework will be set termly and the children have home learning books. Our PE day is Wednesday (4B) and Friday (4E) and the children need to come in their PE kits.

As Coningsby Authors we will be:

Exploring the text 'The Queen's Orang-utan'.

Writing character and setting descriptions, explanations, balanced arguments, newspaper articles, instructions and book reviews.

As Coningsby Geographers we will be:

Finding the location of the Northern and Southern Hemisphere, the Equator, the Tropic of Cancer and Capricorn.

Finding out the difference between the United Kingdom and the British Isles.

Locating and writing about the main islands that surround the United Kingdom and their main features.

As Coningsby Scientists we will be:

Investigating circuits and their components.

Investigating the differences between mains and battery-powered circuits.

Recognising some common conductors and insulators, and associate metals with being good conductors.

Investigating the purposes of conducting and insulating materials.

Using knowledge of conductors and insulators to create switches to complete a circuit?

Planning and carrying out an experiment to see how to change the brightness of a bulb?



As Coningsby believers we will be:

Looking at what pilgrimage is and how followers of different faiths undertake a pilgrimage

Consider our school value of 'Truthfulness.'

As Coningsby Mathematicians we will:

Know that 10 hundreds are equivalent to 1 thousand, and that 1,000 is 10 times the size of 100

Recognise the place value of each digit in four-digit numbers

Divide 1,000 into 2, 4, 5 and 10 equal parts, and read scales/number lines marked in multiples of 1,000 with 2, 4, 5 and 10 equal parts

Multiply and divide whole numbers by 10 and 100
Convert mixed numbers to improper fractions and vice versa.

Add and subtract improper and mixed fractions with the same denominator

Using Pointillism to create works of art.

Reproducing artwork in the style of Mondrian.

Making and editing shapes to create a piece of art.

Changing the shade of a colour for effect.

Experimenting with pop art styles used by the artist Andy Warhol.

Using a range of skills to create a masterpiece.
