As Coningsby authors we will be...

exploring our class texts 'The Enormous Turnip' and 'Jasper's Beanstalk'. We will be retelling the stories through story maps and role play. We will continue practising our phonics skills and applying our sound knowledge to our writing.

As Coningsby scientists we will be...

exploring animals and plants that live in different habitats. We will learn about the lifecycle of different living things including butterflies. We will be learning about plants and what we need to do to take care of them.

As Coningsby believers we will be...

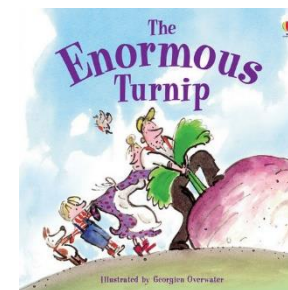
learning all about Easter and why it is a special celebration for Christians. We will be exploring Easter traditions and learning about the Easter story. We will also consider why spring is a time for new beginnings and why some people celebrate this.

In collective worship, we will be learning about thankfulness and how we can show thankfulness every day.

As Coningsby mathematicians we will be...

looking in depth at the numbers 9 and 10 and how these can be represented. We will be learning more about addition and subtraction and using our reasoning skills to explain our answers. We will also be using our understanding of addition and subtraction to learn the number bonds to 10. We will continue our work on shape by exploring the properties of 3D shapes and spotting and correcting the mistakes in more complex repeating patterns.

This term we will be exploring growth and how different plants and animals grow and change over time.

We will learn about how to keep our bodies healthy, including how to keep our teeth clean!

We will be recapping what it means to be a friend by exploring different acts of kindness we can do every day.

exploring watercolour paints and looking at how these are different to poster paints. We will secure our junk modelling skills by making and decorating our own giant vegetables. Towards Easter, we will be making our own spring animals and taking part in lots of exciting Easter crafts!
