

Monday	<p>Pirate description – Using one of the pages below, draw a picture of a pirate. Give your pirate a name. Around the pirate write CVC words to describe your pirate, for example – leg, hat.</p> <p>Now write some sentences to describe the your pirate. Write adjectives (describing words) in red and nouns (naming words) in blue.</p>	<p>Halving – Have a go at splitting even numbers into 2 equal parts. Get an even number of toys and make 2 circles. Tuesday	<p>Imagine you are a pirate and you have some treasure to hide so no one can steal it! Hide it somewhere around your house or in your garden. Draw a map to show where the treasure is hidden. Make sure you put an X where the treasure is hidden! Put labels on your map to show what is on your map.</p>	<p>Pirate Shop - Choose 10 pieces of treasure from home (it could be toys etc.). Ask an adult to give each one a label that says '£1'.</p> <p>Now set up a Pirate Shop and you are the cashier. Ask people at home to shop for treasure from your shop. Your job is to find out how much they have spend by counting the number of pieces of treasure they have bought</p> <p>If they give you £10 how much money do you need to give them back?</p>	
Wednesday	<p>Choose someone from home and give him or her instructions to find your treasure using the map as well. Make sure your instructions are easy to follow. When you find the treasure make sure they don't steal it. If they try to then make them walk the plank!</p>	<p>Your pirate crew needs to get fit and healthy. Your job is to show them what to do to get fit. Ask an adult to time you for 1 minute and try to do the following activities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Hopping on 1 leg</li> <li>• Star jumps</li> <li>• Head, shoulders, knees and toes</li> </ul> <p>How many of each activity could you do? Write down the number for each.</p> <p>Which could you do the most of?</p>	
<p>Reading – Make sure you are reading with an adult at home everyday. Try to read books about pirates and the sea.</p>
