Monday	<p>This week we are focussing on the film, <i>'The Jungle Book'</i> (based on the story by Rudyard Kipling)</p> <p>If you have the film, enjoy watching it as a family. There are lots of short clips of the songs and best bits from the film on YouTube also.</p>	<p>Days of the week: Sing days of the week song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0CuphkWcdDEg.</p> <p>Maybe you can make up your own days of the week song to a tune of your choosing! If possible, please video it and send to us on tapestry! Think about what you do on each day? Can you make a simple diary for the week?</p>	<p>1. Watch the 'Super Movers' alphabet song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=jYeMpUdufNk</p> <p>Can you make a set of alphabet cards and see if you can put them into the correct alphabetic order?</p> <p>2. Reinforcing learning from last week: Can you match lowercase letters to the capital letters. Can you say the sound and letter name?</p>	<p>Social and Emotional: Baloo the bear becomes Mowgli's best friend: think about your special friends. How do they make you feel special? What do you like about your friends? What makes a good friend? Maybe you could create a picture for your special friends.</p>
Tuesday	<p>Who is your favourite character from 'The Jungle Book'? Why do you like them? Can you describe the character to someone? Draw a picture and write about your favourite character? (Remember to use a capital letter for the start of a name!)</p>	<p>Months of the year: months of the year song. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=5enDRrWyXaw</p> <p>Can you name all the months of the year? If you have a calendar at home, ask your adult if they can show you. Talk with your adult about all the special events that happen throughout the year and in which month. When is your birthday? Members of your family or friend's birthdays?</p>	<p>3. Sing-along to the Tricky word songs! https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TvMyssfAUx0 https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=R087LYrRpgY</p> <p>Can you find the tricky word's in the wordsearches?</p> <p>4. Write a sentence! Choose a tricky word and make up a sentence with the word in. It can be as silly or as sensible as you like! Remember: say the sentence first, check it has a tricky word in it. Remember a capital letter at the beginning of your sentence, finger spaces and a full stop at the end!</p>	 <p>Creative: Make a Kaa snake! You could make your snake from paper chains, or maybe a spiral coil snake! Remember to add a snake scale pattern, printing using bubble wrap is super for this! Follow the lines as you cut out the spiral.</p> <p>Physical development: Can you draw and cut out leaves to make jungle vines? Save these and tomorrow use them to decorate your jungle fort!</p>
Wednesday	<p>Watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=c6e3lTsjLRl</p> <p>Baloo sings about the 'Bare Necessities'; the things that he needs to live, that he loves. Can you make a list of all the things you need as well as all your favourite things?</p>	<p>Seasons: Think about the four seasons of the year: What do you already know about these? What are they called? Can you draw a picture of what happens in each season?</p>	<p>5. Play a game of QuickWrite sounds and words! Ask your adult to challenge you to write all the sounds they say in one minute! Now, how many key words can you write in 2 minutes?</p> <p>Remember: Try to read every day and share a book. Keep practising skills of sounding out and blending to read words.</p>	<p>Sing a Song: Sing-along to the Bare Necessities song! Make up your own dance moves! It would be super to show us by recording and uploading to tapestry!!</p> <p>Being Imaginative: Can you build a jungle fort? Use your vines from yesterday! Use big boxes, cushions, furniture (with permission and supervision from your adult!), really anything you can imagine! Imagine you are Mowgli in his jungle</p>

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			Also use phonics websites, apps and games! Don't forget the daily phonics sessions on YouTube: Letters and Sounds for home and school.	home.. maybe Bagheera or Baloo might come to visit!
Thursday	Can you make up a jungle menu for Mowgli's dinner? Be as imaginative as you can! Maybe spider sausages and snake spaghetti!	Time on the clock. How many different clocks can you find in your home? How are they different? (Some maybe digital too!) Can you make your own analogue 'clock'? Look at how to show the times, o'clock and half past using the big hand. Can you make different o'clock and half past times with your adult? In your daily diary from earlier this week, you could add what time you get up, eat lunch, have tea, go the bed!
