We hope you had a great Christmas holiday, we are so excited to welcome you all back to our classrooms. This term we have so much to look forward to!

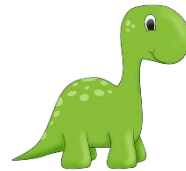
Please remember to share with us on tapestry when your child does some fantastic learning at home! We love to see what you all have been up to.

We will be taking part in archaeological digs, creating small world dinosaur adventures and learning what the world looked like millions of years ago. We will also explore how different things grow and change overtime. We will show our show noticing skills by planting seeds and watching the changes that occur throughout the term.
