## Welcome back to EYFS

We hope you all had a well-deserved Easter break and are ready for a fantastic summer term.

Please continue to use Class Dojo to message us with any queries or questions and Tapestry to share your child's learning.

Thank you for the reading you're doing with your child. We have made the decision to change books once a week (Wednesday) in EYFS to provide the children with the opportunity to feel secure with the focus sounds in each book. Please continue to send your child with their reading book every day so we can hear them read in school. Please note that any reading can be recorded into reading journals, not just school books!

Please remember that our PE day is Monday so children should arrive in school in their PE kits and will remain in PE kits all day.

Most of our PE sessions will take place outside this term so please ensure that PE kit is weather appropriate.

### As Coningsby mathematicians we will:

Explore the numbers beyond 10.  
Secure our knowledge of adding and subtracting two single-digit numbers.  
Develop our knowledge of patterns and begin to explore number patterns.  
Continue to explore shape and develop our understanding of spatial reasoning.

### As Coningsby authors we will:

Explore the features of traditional tales.  
Develop our stamina for writing sentences and begin to write for purpose.  
Practise using our phase 2 and 3 sounds in words and practice writing with correct spellings of some non-decodable words.

This term we will be exploring different mysterious creatures. We will explore the features of traditional tales and look in depth at the features of a narrative. Our learning environments will provide children with exciting opportunities to investigate different elements of our topic, whilst exploring their own personal interests too.
