### **As Coningsby Mathematicians we will:**

Using and calculating with negative numbers.  
Solving problems using the order of operations (BODMAS)  
Solving problems involving all 4 operations and using estimation to check answers  
Multiplying 2 proper fractions and dividing a proper fraction by a whole number  
Solving problems by calculating percentages  
Using knowledge of fraction, decimal and percentage equivalences  
Calculating the mean.  
Interpreting pie charts.

### **As Coningsby believers we will:**

Learn about Perseverance through the Bible story: The Parable of the Lost Sheep

In RE we will be exploring the Christian story of creation and also the scientific big bang and looking at whether these are conflicting or complementary ideas.

### **As Coningsby Authors we will:**

Be studying the book, Hansel and Gretel by Neil Gaiman  
Write a re-tell of Hansel and Gretel with an alternative ending.  
Focus on using parenthesis, formal language and atmospheric language in our writing.



### **As Coningsby Geographers we will be exploring:**

Climate change:  
What is climate change?  
What are the causes and effects of extreme weather?  
How do time zones work?  
How do I use an atlas to locate places?

### **As Coningsby Scientists we will:**

Be finding out about evolution and inheritance.  
Be looking at what off-spring inherit from their parents and any variations that occur.  
We will be looking at the environment animals live in and how they have adapted to them.

### **As Coningsby Artists & Designers we will:**

Be focussing on the artists Leonora Carrington and Marc Chagall who combine images of animals and humans in their work, inspired by myths and legends. We will use a range of sketching pencils to create our own drawings in a similar style, inspired by a character from our favourite story.
