As Coningsby Artists & Designers we will:

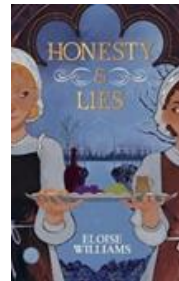
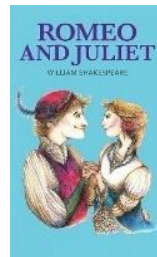
Design, build and evaluate a steady-hand game using an electricity circuit.
