Know and use the correct formula for calculating the area of rectangles, triangles and

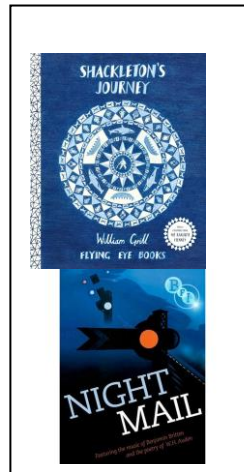
As Coningsby believers we will:
