### **As Coningsby believers we will:**

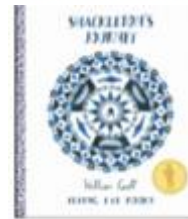
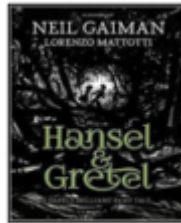
Learn about forgiveness through the Bible story: The Lord's Prayer Matthew 6: 9-13
