- We will be reading Escape from Pompeii and The Orchard Book of Greek Myths.
- We will develop our skills as writers, including writing setting descriptions, character descriptions, diaries and letters and retelling the story in our own words.
- We will use No Nonsense Spelling to learn spelling rules.
- We will continue to practice our handwriting using 'Letter join'.

Art

- In Art we will be looking at the artist Kara Walker and Underwater Scenes.
- We will name tools and materials we have used.
- We will experiment with a range of collage techniques such as tearing, overlapping and layering to create images and represent textures.

Religious Education

- In RE we will be learning what 'Being Human' means.
- We will be asking the question: How does faith and belief affect the way people live their lives?
- We will be thinking and learning about our community, worship and celebration and asking the questions: How do people express their religion and beliefs?

Science

- This term we will learning about Light and Dark.
- We will develop our scientific enquiry skills.
- We will recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light.
- We will notice that light is reflected from surfaces.
- We will recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes.
- We will recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object.
- We will find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.

Maths

This term we will be learning a range of mathematical strands:

- Time
- Multiplication and Division
- Geometry – Properties of shape.
- Position and Direction

Year 3 will consolidate their knowledge of the 2, 3, 4-, 5-, 8- and 10-times tables.

Year 4 will consolidate knowledge of all times tables and will complete the Multiplication Test.

Computing

- We will learn how to use a range of techniques to create a stop-frame animation using tablets.
- We will apply those skills to create a story-based animation and conclude with adding other types of media to their animation.

Geography

- This term we will be asking the question, 'What are volcanoes and earthquakes and where do they occur'?
- We will learn why Mount St Helens and Vesuvius are important mountains as well as why people live near volcanoes, and how do they use the land around them.
