As Coningsby Geographers we will be exploring:

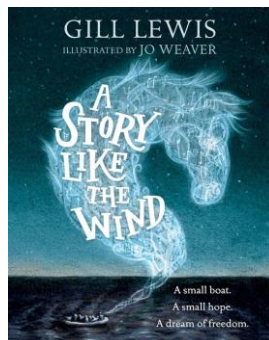
Maps and different settlements
