We will explore eating a healthy diet and the effect that this has on our bodies.

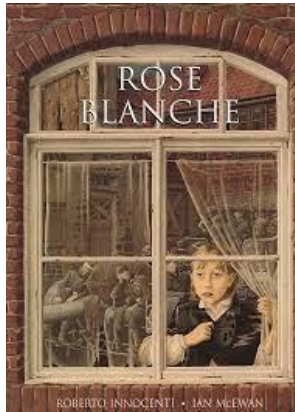
We will learn the names of the parts of the circulatory system and explore keeping this healthy.
