WELCOME

WE ARE LEARNING...

MATHS

We will be exploring subitising, early counting and composition this half term. Our focus is working with mastery with lower numbers ready to apply the same skills with higher ones.

LITERACY

In Literacy we will be exploring the a few texts in depth. These are, The Squirrels that Sqaubbled, The Diversity Book and A Little Bit Brave.

In phonics we will be working at a fast pace teaching sounds from week 2. We will send home videos on ClassDojo for children to practise at home.
