"Oh my, look at all these magnificent creatures!" explained Charles Darwin.

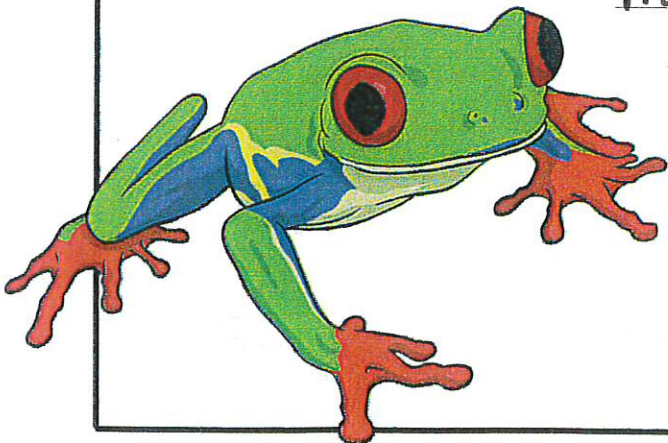
"I've never seen anything like it before!"
