As Coningsby Authors we will...

Channel our inner Bear Grylls responding to our beautiful text, *The Lost Book of Adventure*. We will be writing an information leaflet about survival in the wild and an exploration narrative about a dangerous rainforest adventure..

As Coningsby Historians we will...

be learning about the Romans. We discover what an Empire is and learn about the Roman Empire. Why they invaded and settled in Britain. How the Celtic people felt about the Roman presence. We will learn about aspects of Roman life and society and their legacy in England.

As Coningsby Scientists we will...

be exploring Forces- a physics unit. We will have lots of fun building on our knowledge of forces from year 3 investigating air resistance, gravity, friction, levers, gears and pulleys and develop our disciplinary skills by thinking of our questions and set up our own experiments to investigate these. This is a very practical unit of work which will extend over the last two terms of

As Coningsby Mathematicians we will...

Round whole and decimal numbers, add and subtract numbers using formal written methods, practice our addition and subtraction skills whilst solving word problems. Find multiples, factors and prime numbers. Read and interpret line graphs. Further develop our long multiplication skills and practice the formal written method.



As Coningsby Artists & Designers we will...

be developing our sketching and learning new shading techniques with pencils learning to produce increasingly life- like 3D artwork.

As Coningsby believers we will...

Look at how religious views and beliefs are expressed through the arts. Make links between symbolic representation in pictures and beliefs. Look in depth at how the arts are used to communicate spiritual beliefs and values to others.

Our unit this term is Freedom to Improvise.
