As Coningsby Scientists we will...

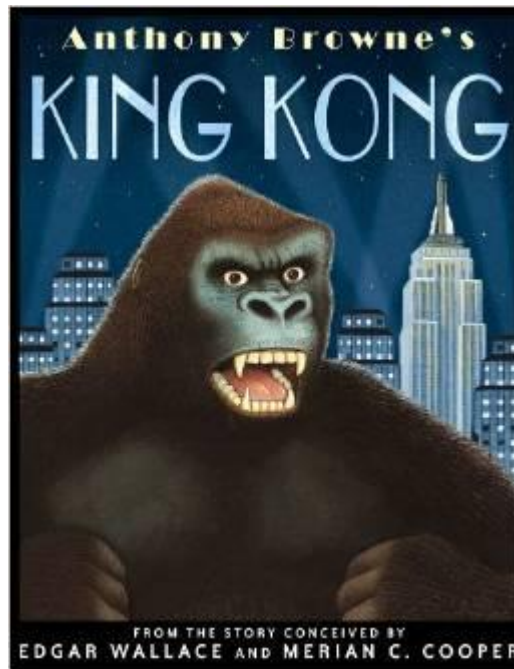
