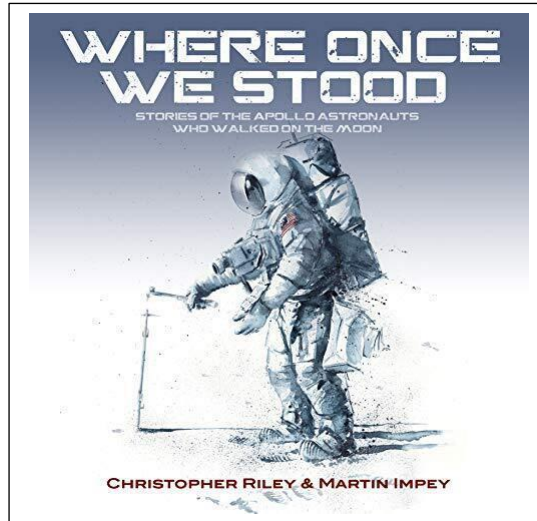
As Coningsby Historians we will...

## Year 5 Term 2 Curriculum
