In RE will be exploring the Christian story of creation and also the scientific big bang and looking at whether these are conflicting or complementary ideas.

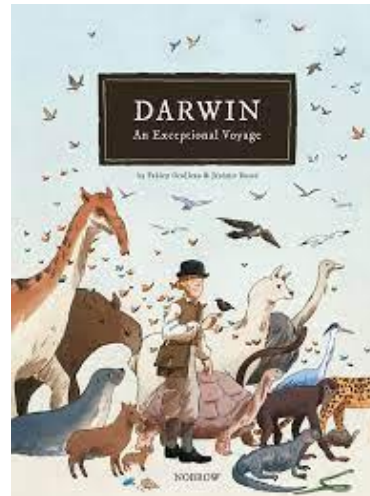
As Coningsby Authors we will:
