Explore the question:

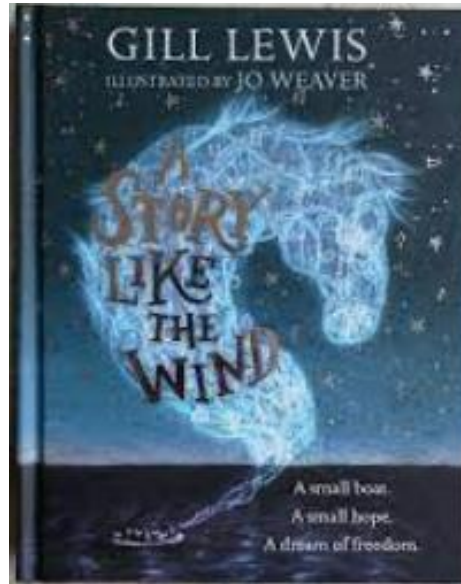
Do you have to believe in God to be good?

We will be comparing different settlements using maps and aerial views.

We will be reading and giving grid references and using these to navigate routes.

Be studying the book 'A Story like the Wind' by Gill Lewis. We will look at how the author uses personification to describe objects in the story and how the choices of vocabulary help to create the mood and build atmosphere.
