We will be retelling stories in the correct sequence, using story language.

We will be reading our own writing to check that it makes sense and that we are using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.

In Maths...

We will be doubling, sharing and grouping, and identifying odd and even numbers. We will be using positional language and working on our spatial reasoning skills.

We will continue to work on our number bonds to five and ten.

In The World, Expressive Arts and R.E...

We will be reflecting on how we have changed since starting school.

We will explore pirates of the past and their ships. We will find out about fossils.

We will make observational drawings of seaside creatures and objects

We will explore floating and sinking.
