This term we will continue to put updates onto Class Dojo so please check it regularly for any updates. We have been sending home login details for the Numblocks game which we encourage children to use at home for five minutes a day. This supports their maths recall skills.



Please could the children bring a named drink reading book and record in bookbag with them each day. We will also be doing more visits to the Mystical Garden so if you have named wellies you can leave in school that would be brilliant.



This term we will be exploring space and the marvellous creations which have got us there. We will celebrate our local RAF context. We will learn a little about Remembrance Day.

We will be comparing life as an astronaut to life in the RAF. We will explore Amelia Earhart's story and welcoming an RAF visitor to speak to us about their role.



As young artists we will be using our learning about space to explore cutting and sticking. Using PVA to papier mache. We will explore Van Gogh's painting 'Starry Night' and look at some of the techniques he used. Later we will be all about the Christmas decorations with plenty of glitter!



As part of our literacy work this term we will be reading the story of Star in a Jar. We will explore the text and increase our ability to come up with and hold sentences in our heads ready for writing longer phrases. We will be learning lots of adjectives which help us to make our sentences exciting.



As part of our science work this term we will be exploring all things space. We will be learning about the forces push and pull. We will link this to gravity and what life is like for astronauts. We will also be exploring day and night through shadows.



As mathematicians we will be learning how to work with numbers up to 5. We will be giving one more and one less, learning number bonds and finding different ways of representing, splitting and building each number.



We will be learning about important figures in Christianity and Islam. We will be looking at how special events are celebrated in different religious traditions. Diwali, Hannukah and Christmas will be our focus celebrations this coming term.
