As Coningsby Authors, we will:

Be exploring the text *The Last Wolf* by Mini Grey. We will be looking at the suffixes *ed* and *s* and *es*.

We will write our own narrative for a story about hunting.

Our learning will then move on to writing instructions for a recipe. We will also look at the conjunctions *and*, *so* because.

As Coningsby Scientists, we will:

Continue with our topic of, 'Animals including Humans'. We will be carrying out different investigations to see if older children are faster and if older children have bigger heads! We will also have some caterpillars to observe over time as they change into butterflies as part of lifecycles.

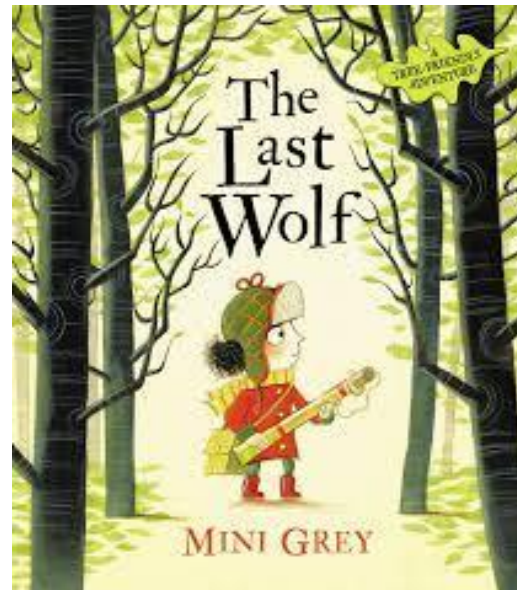
As Coningsby believers, we will:

Learn about the importance of Christmas for Christians. We will be looking at the Christmas story in detail and talking about how we know Jesus was an important person for Christians. We will be considering his impact on Christianity and how his birth is celebrated.

As Coningsby Mathematicians, we will:

In Year 1 we will start by looking at position and direction and using directional vocabulary. We will move on to place value from 50 to 100 and beyond, counting forwards and backwards, building the numbers and comparing them. We will then learn about money and time!

In Year 2 we will be doing statistics looking at tally charts and interpreting data. We will then look at position and direction and consolidate our learning from the year so far.



As Coningsby Artists and Designers, we will:

Be looking at the work of the famous sculpture, Joy Danila. We will discuss what we like and don't like about the artist work. We will then develop our clay modelling skills to create face pots!

As Coningsby ICT experts, we will:

begin to understand that sequences of commands have an outcome, and make predictions based on this learning. We will use and modify designs to create our own quiz questions in ScratchJr, and realise these designs in ScratchJr using blocks of code. Finally, we will evaluate our work and make improvements to their programming projects.

As Coningsby Geographers, we will:

be finding out where our local seaside resort is and identify the human and physical features of a seaside town. We will explore how seaside towns have changed over time. Our learning will then take us around the UK recapping our knowledge on the British Isles. We will then explore the coastal town of St Ives and compare it to Skegness.
