Thursday 15th Jun - Rabbits



Be learning about light and dark, focussing on mirrors and reflection. We will be learning all about how mirrors work and how images are reflected.

Be learning all about volcanoes. We will be exploring the structure of the earth and how volcanoes are formed. We will explore famous volcanoes around the world, and the impact these volcanoes have on the local population. We will also explore Asia as a continent.

As Coningsby Mathematicians we will:

Shape:

We will be learning about different angles, 2D shapes and 3D shapes.

We will be learning about pictograms and bar charts, and exploring how to collect and represent our own data

We will continue to work on our fluency. We will be focusing on recalling addition and subtraction facts and revisiting our place value knowledge.
