be responding to our text for this term “The Lost Book of Adventure.” For our extended pieces of writing this term, we will be writing a survival narrative and a survival guide.

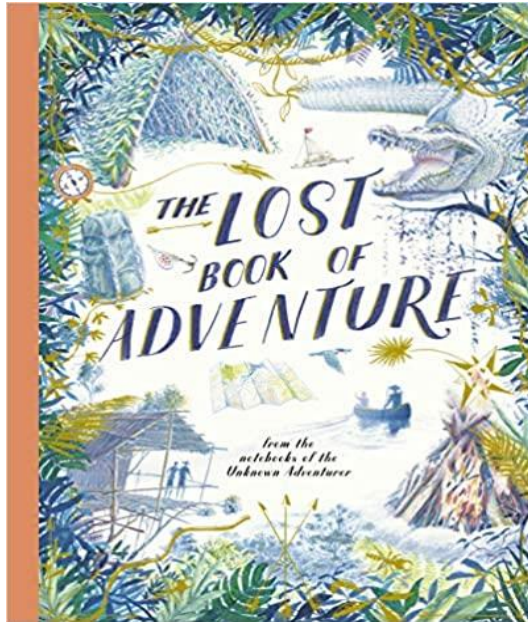
As Coningsby Geographers we will...

be learning about the course of a river and related vocabulary as well as some of the features that can be found here. We will learn about British rivers and those that can be found in the wider world. This will be followed by a focus on different world mountain ranges.

Year 5 Term 5 Curriculum

As Coningsby Scientists we will...

Begin to explore forces covering the areas of friction, gravity, air resistance and water resistance. In addition to this we will also be investigating the forces used to move/lift heavy objects – gears/pulleys/levers. This unit of work will continue into Term 6 as well.



As Coningsby Artists & Designers we will...

be learning about sketching skills and techniques. We will focus on sketching a range of items from close observation and will also relate this to our rivers topic.

As Coningsby Mathematicians we will...

Be classifying angles – acute, obtuse and reflex. Learn to calculate angles around a point and on a straight line and also estimate and draw angles accurately.

Distinguish between regular and irregular polygons and be able to identify 3D shapes.

Learn to read and plot coordinates on a grid and describe translations of points and shapes.

As Coningsby believers we will...
