As Coningsby Authors we will...

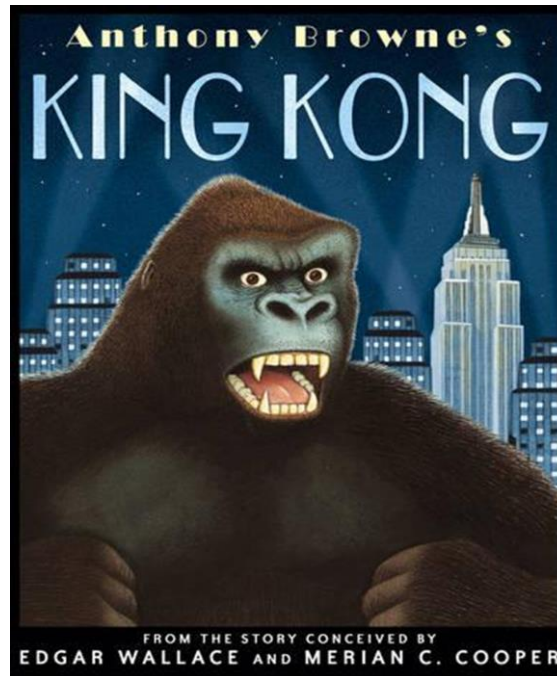
be responding to our text for this term "King Kong" We will learn how to write a Dilemma Narrative and a Balanced Argument.

As Coningsby Historians we will...

be learning about the countries involved, key events and who the leaders were in World War II – Neville Chamberlain, Winston Churchill, Adolf Hitler, Benito Mussolini. We will also discuss societal roles and how this has influenced the world today. We will make links to our local area, particularly the role of the air bases during this war.

As Coningsby Scientists we will...

be exploring life cycles of plants (flowering and non-flowering), mammals, insects and birds. We will compare the stages of life cycles and identify features of these plants/ animal groups.



As Coningsby Artists & Designers we will...

Be learning about air raids in order to design, build and evaluate a model Anderson shelter.

As Coningsby Mathematicians we will...

Learn to compare, order and convert decimals, fractions and percentages. We will also focus on calculating the area and perimeter of various shapes.

Followed by reading and interpreting graphs, charts and tables.
