be responding to our text for this term "FARThER" – by Grahame Baker-Smith We will look closely at narrative writing and letter writing using this text.

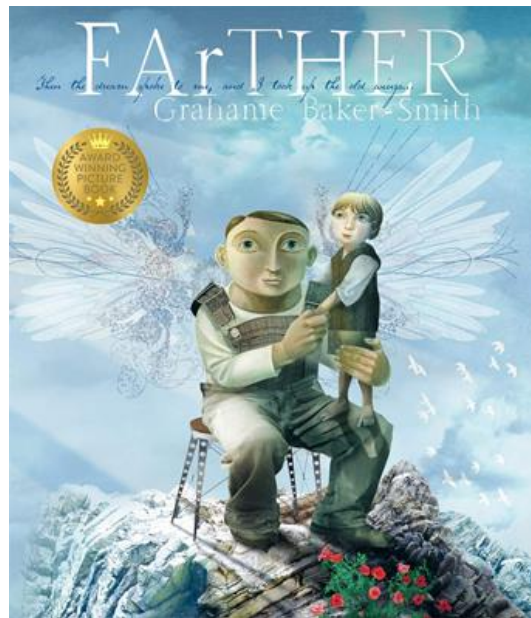
As Coningsby Historians we will...

5 Term 1 Curriculum

As Coningsby Scientists we will...

be exploring the The unit of work called 'Animals-including humans. This unit of work looks at the different life stages for humans. We will also be discovering how to maintain a healthy body.



As Coningsby Mathematicians we will...

focus on place value, methods of addition and subtraction. We will continue to develop our mental arithmetic skills by improving our recall of key number facts. We will apply our learning through mastery (problem-solving) activities each week. Please encourage your child to practise their Times Tables regularly using Times Table Rockstars which the children can access at home.

As Coningsby believers we will...

read and discuss the Bible story – 'David and Jonathan' – 1 Samuel 18 and discuss our core value of Friendship.

In RE, we will be looking at Hinduism. We will be drawing similarities and differences between Hindu and Christian beliefs and researching how worship takes place in each religion.
