We will read Wolves by Emily Gravett, using the story to write captions, character descriptions and information texts while exploring themes of friendship and first impressions.

We will also read Billy and the Beast by Nadia Shireen, creating wanted posters, summaries and our own stories while discussing bravery, courage and standing up for others.

The Arts

We will learn about the artist L.S. Lowry and explore some of his famous paintings. We will investigate how Lowry painted people, buildings and scenes from everyday life. We will develop our painting skills by experimenting with colour, brush control and different painting techniques to create our own Lowry-inspired artwork.

Religious Education

This term, we will explore what Christians believe about God through Bible stories and discussion. We will learn about key Christian beliefs, including creation, love, forgiveness and trust. We will have opportunities to ask questions, share our own ideas and develop our understanding of how faith influences the lives of Christians today.

Year 1/2

Science

We will explore a range of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, metal, glass, fabric and paper. We'll investigate the properties of different materials and discuss why particular materials are used for different objects. We will compare and group materials based on their features and carry out simple investigations to help us understand the world around us.

Maths

Maths - Year 1

We will develop our place value knowledge within 100 and begin learning about time, including days, months and times of day.

Maths - Year 2

We will continue developing place value skills within 100 and learn to tell and write the time on analogue and digital clocks.

PSHE

We will explore our strengths, talents and achievements, recognising what makes each of us unique. We will celebrate our successes, build confidence and understand that everyone has different qualities and skills. We will learn about the people who help us and keep us safe at school and in the wider community.

Geography

We will learn about the seven continents and five oceans of the world and locate them on maps and globes. We will identify different countries and their capital cities and learn interesting facts about them. We will use maps and atlases to develop our geographical knowledge and understanding of the wider world.
