As Coningsby Scientists we will:

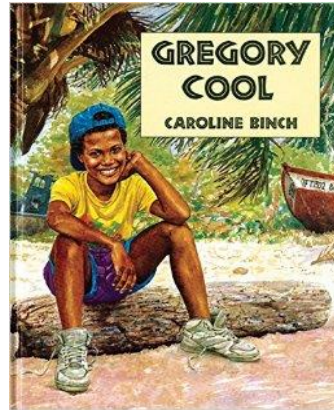
Answer the question – Is water more important than anything else?
