

English

This term we are looking at the texts of King Kong by Anthony Browne and The Lost Happy Endings. These books will inspire our narrative writing whilst looking at the grammar skills of punctuating dialogue, prepositions, relative clauses, adverbials, synonyms and figurative language. We will use these skills to help to create descriptive writing, character descriptions, setting descriptions, adventure blogs and capturing a moment in time effectively.

Art

This term, we will explore the work of J.M.W. Turner, and how he used watercolour techniques to create different moods and atmospheres in his paintings. Children will experiment with a range of watercolour.

Religious Education

This term we will explore the relationship between being human and being creative. Through engaging with a range of religious traditions, practices and texts, pupils will explore the role of music in expressing identity, belief and belonging.

Science

This term we will be learning about Earth and Space. We will explore:

- Our solar system, the planets in it and how they move
- The shape of the Sun, Moon and Earth and how scientists know.
- How the Moon moves around the Earth.
- Why day and night occur.
- Why we have different seasons.

Maths

This term we will be learning to:

- Convert between standard units of time
- Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 10,000,000 (yr 6) 1,000,000 (yr 5)
- Read, write, order and compare decimal numbers.
- Improve our mental strategies when calculating
- Multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100, 1000
- Read, write and convert between units of measure for length, mass and volume.

PSHE

In PSHE this term, we will be exploring families, friendships and relationships. We will learn that every family is different and discuss what makes relationships healthy, caring and respectful.

Geography

This term in Geography, we will be learning about natural disasters. We will be looking at: volcanic eruptions, flooding, earthquakes, droughts and wildfires whilst looking at how weather patterns and geographical location contribute towards the cause of natural disasters.
