At Coningsby St. Michael's, we believe all areas of the curriculum are important. This term we would like you to choose a minimum of 4 activities from the grid below, as your homework tasks. Other than reading and times table practise, no weekly homework will be set. We hope that this style of homework will encourage everyone to take part and give parents a chance to become more involved in working with their children on fun, creative and exciting activities. Please ask parents, family members or friends to join in and have fun. You can bring in writing tasks, evidence logs, photos or any other evidence of your learning. We are hoping by giving everyone choices that a selection of activities will be completed by pupils with support from family members.			
Maths – Find out the distance each planet is from the Sun in our solar system and put them in order. Find out the length of 1 day for each planet and order this.	English - Write a short character description of a character of your choice from your favourite book. Include noun phrases, adjectives, adverbs and prepositions to help describe.	Science – Research and explain how and why a solar eclipse occurs.	Art – Choose an emotion or mood and create a small watercolour painting to represent it. Think carefully about the colours you choose and how you can use different techniques, such as blending.
RE – Create a small sketch/a song/short description showing how a religious person might express their beliefs through art, symbols, music or writing.	PSHE - Create a recipe for a healthy relationship. Think about the qualities that help relationships to be happy, healthy and respectful.	Geography - Look up Pompeii, what is its significance? How does this link to natural disasters?	Science – Create a moon diary for a month. Draw or take a picture of the moon to show how it changes during that month. Find out what the different phases of the moon are called.
English - Write some dialogue between two characters, this could be from our book or another book of your choosing-remember to punctuate correctly using inverted commas.	Geography – To research a country that gets a lot of flooding and explain why this might happen.	Maths – Record the time of three activities during your day eg journey to school, tea time, bath time. Record the time that these start and finish at and the duration of each activity.	Cooking – Find out how to cook your favourite meal. What is it and what is it your favourite? Support an adult to make this meal.
Reading – Children should be encouraged to read every day. If you can, encourage them to read out loud and ask them about how we use EARS in school to practice reading with expression.
