be responding to our text for this term "Letters From The Lighthouse" We will learn how to write recounts, diary entries, wanted posters, radio broadcasts and newspaper reports.


As Coningsby Historians we will...

be learning about the countries involved, key events and who the leaders were in World War II – Neville Chamberlain, Winston Churchill, Adolf Hitler, Benito Mussolini. We will also discuss societal roles and how this has influenced the world today. We will make links to our local area, particularly the role of the air bases during this war.

As Coningsby Scientists we will...

be exploring life cycles of plants (flowering and non-flowering), mammals, insects and birds. We will compare the stages of life cycles and identify features of these plants/ animal groups and even host our own butterfly garden.

As part of our science work this term we will be growing a range of plants which are to be planted in the school grounds.



As Coningsby Mathematicians we will...

focus on adding, subtracting and multiplying fractions. We will be calculating fractions of varying amounts and identifying decimal and percentage equivalents of different fractions.

read and discuss Psalm 100-5 and discuss our core value of Thankfulness.

In RE, we will be continuing to focus on Christianity exploring whether Jesus was the Saviour of mankind.
