

As Coningsby Historians we will...

be learning about the Vikings and their culture. Our investigations will also look at how and when the Vikings raided and settled in England. We will also be looking at their beliefs and who they worship.

Year 5 Term 2 Curriculum

As Coningsby Scientists we will...

be looking at the Celestial bodies that make up our Solar System and how the planets’ orbits differ. We will use the Earth’s orbit to explain why we have day and explore the phases of the Moon.



As Coningsby Artists & Designers we will...

be using our DT skills to create lunar/moon buggies where the children will design, build and evaluate their own work.

As Coningsby Mathematicians we will...

Identify multiples and factors of numbers, recognising what prime, square and cube numbers are and how to multiply and divide numbers by 10, 100, 1000. We will be calculating areas and perimeters of shapes. We will apply our learning through mastery (problem-solving) activities each week.

As Coningsby believers we will...

read and discuss the Bible story – The Story of Nehemiah (Nehemiah 8:10) and discuss our core value of Perseverance.

In RE, we will be focusing on Islam. We will be learning how Muslim teachings guide them in their everyday lives and what the Qur’an teaches Muslims about how they should treat others.
