As Coningsby Historians we will be exploring:

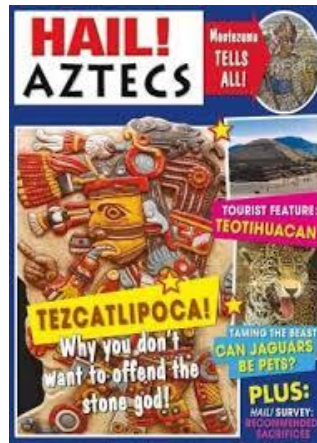
The Aztecs-
