As night fell, the Cyclops fell into a deep sleep.

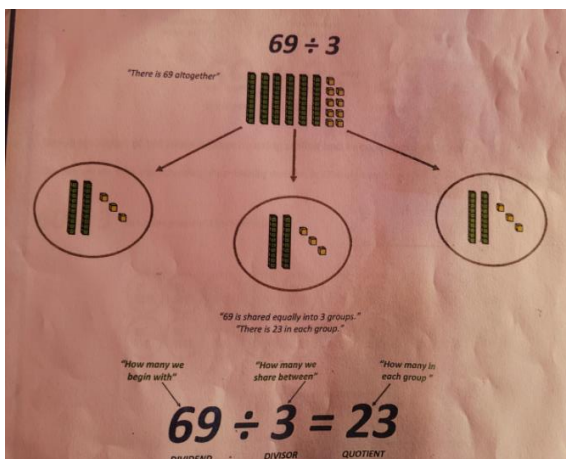
Task 2
