Geography

Do you know where the equator is and where the northern and southern hemispheres are? Look at a map or globe or research on the internet. See if you can find what the temperatures are like at these specific parts of the world. Then colour in the map to show what the different temperatures are.

The equator is where the hottest countries are because they are closer to the sun and the polar regions are colder because they are further from the sun.

Activities

Colour in the maps using a key to describe the temperatures; cold, temperate, warm and hot.

Ext: research countries that sit on the equator, and northern and southern hemispheres.

Science

This week we are looking at the different habitats in Africa. Savannah, desert, ocean and rainforest. Can you research the different animals that live in these habitats? Make a list of them then try to find out why one animal from each habitat is suited to it.
