What is a habitat?

This term's topic is Living Things and their Habitats, what do you think this means?

How many animals can you list that would live in each of these habitats? Think about birds and insects too.

Explain that a habitat is the natural type of place an animal lives in. Discuss how they need air, food and water to survive.

Explain that some habitats can be very small and are called micro-habitats.

Go for a walk around your garden to see if you can spot any habitats or micro-habitats. Talk about what a micro-habitat is (E.g. flower beds, hedges, plant troughs, grass, pond, tree, leaf litter, under stones)

Task 2 - Choose an animal you are already familiar with from one of those habitats and draw it in its habitat and write about it.
