Mercury



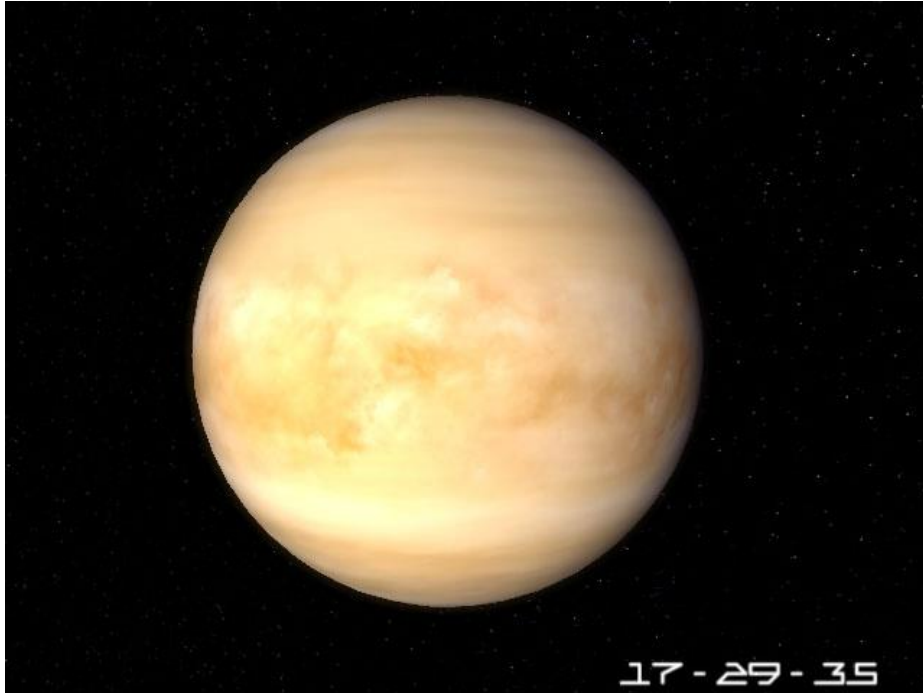
Fact 1: Mercury is the closest planet to the sun and the fastest moving planet.

Saturn

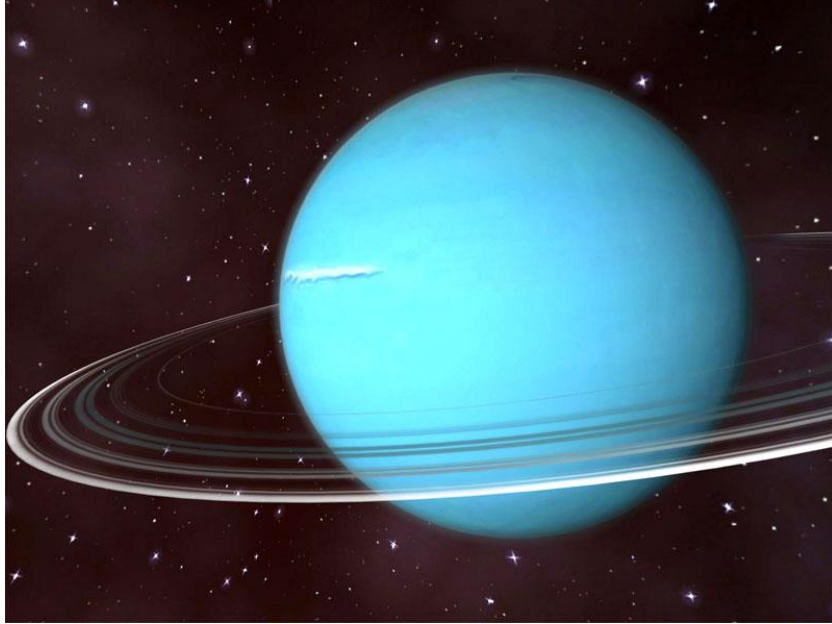


Fact 1: Saturn is the 6th planet from the Sun. It is the 2nd largest planet in our solar system. It has rings made of ice.

Uranus



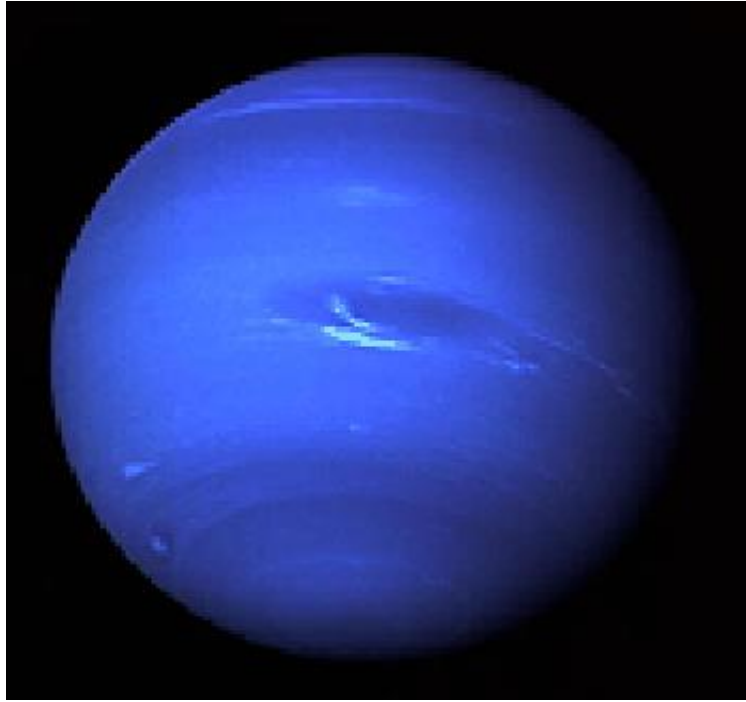
Fact 1: Uranus is the 7th planet from the sun.
