4. Now see if you can answer these 2 step problems:

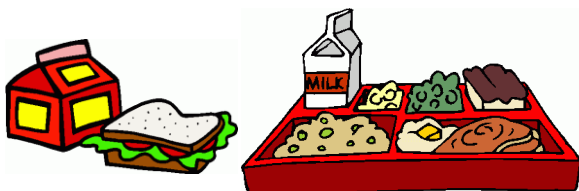
1. There are 65 children at Hill School.

He uses these five coins to make the call.

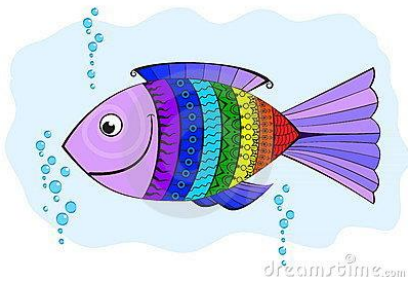


How much money has he got left from the £1?
