

Home Learning W/C 09.11.20

Maths:

This week, we are working on subtracting a 2-digit number from another 2-digit number.

Please use <https://mathsbot.com/manipulatives/blocks> to support with showing how many tens and how many ones are in a number and then work on taking away the tens and ones as necessary. There are some questions on the website to have a look at, including some problem solving questions. Please talk through these problems and ask the children to explain their thinking.

English:

This week, we are writing setting descriptions using expanded noun phrases - these are descriptive phrases using at least 2 adjectives and a noun (for example: beautiful, emerald leaves). As we are learning about space this term, you could use the image below or choose a different image for your child to write about.



History:

This week, we are learning the names of the planet and their order from the sun. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=PCxjuDePdCI> is a song about the planets, including some facts. Attached on the website is a sheet with the planets that could be coloured and ordered if you have access to a printer (no worries if not).

Science:

We are continuing our learning about materials and learning some new vocabulary - flexible, rigid, elastic and stiff. Please find some objects in your home that would fit with these words and have a discussion around why these attributes are important for those objects - for example, cutlery needs to be rigid so that it doesn't bend when we try to eat our food.
