

## Year 2 - home learning activities - 21.9.20

### English

This week in English children will be learning how to write an information text.

Use this information to help you write an information text about The Great Fire of London.

Task 1 - look around your house and see how many books, magazines or newspapers you can find.

Task 2 - organise them into fiction and non-fiction

Fiction is made up, you need to use your imagination when you are writing it. Types of fiction include plays, stories and poems.

Non-fiction is about facts, you can't just make it up.

Now look at the features of each.

Non-fiction books will have a contents page, an index and a glossary. Have a look at what each of these includes.

Task 3 - Now have a go at writing an information booklet about The Great Fire of London.

Write in sections starting with what happened on Sunday then draw a picture to show what happened.

Keep going all the way through, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

When you have finished, write your contents page, then write your index page and then write your glossary.

Present your work as neatly as possible, use your neatest handwriting and check your spellings.
